### **Have the following information available to include in the form:**

Session title

Primary Contact

Names, contact information, and affiliations of all participants

Category (45-minute session or lightning session)

Abstract (150-200 words)

Key words (5-7)

**What are lightning sessions?** Lightning sessions consist of a series of brief 12 minute presentations. Presenter gives a quick snapshot of the project, limited to summarizing key points and takeaways, similar to an elevator speech.

### **Guidance on Lightning Sessions:**

- Prepare your presentation to include the following talking points:
  - Specific planning problem your project addresses or addressed.
  - Methodology and implementation strategies.
  - Data-driven measures/tools used.
  - Next steps.
  - Lessons learned.
  - If your presentation focuses on a research project, include the research question.
  - If your project or research included collaboration, acknowledge contributors.
- Tone should be conversational; do not read from a script.
- Focus on compelling highlights of your work.
- Optional: PowerPoint presentation/demo of the project.
