

**Time Travel: Cerrillos Road Santa Fe 130 Years Back to the Future**

To tell the story of Cerrillos Road, the automobile spine of Santa Fe, is to tell the story of road development in New Mexico. From a planning perspective, the 1912 and 1947 Santa Fe Comp Plans paved the way. Cerrillos Road provides a living footprint of Santa Fe's past 100 years of transition to suburban settlement patterns. After 130 years of incremental development, from its headwaters of downtown Santa Fe to its delta at I-25, the impacts of this roadway cannot be underscored. Cerrillos Road, an automobile dominant public space, offers opportunities to rethink roadway design in the spirit of equity, sustainability, economic vitality and innovation. How we got here may help us revision roads for resilience.
